JOB CONTEXT: Since the earthquake in Haiti in 2010 the rehabilitation needs have multiplied whereas there is a huge shortage of local qualified rehabilitation professionals available to respond to these needs and take over from the expatriate staff. The Handicap International Development Division has launched a project which aims to provide training and qualifications to Haitians in the rehabilitation and orthopaedic fields.

JOB DESCRIPTION: You are in charge of the project management and the coordination of 2 trainings for rehabilitation and orthopaedic technicians.

You are responsible for a team of trainers as well as representing Handicap International in various work groups ("Project Steering Committee", "Physical Therapy Education Committee", and "P&O Education Committee").

Your main challenges and goals are to ensure the project and budget management as well as overseeing that these trainings are completed, acknowledged and recognized along with the Haitian Association of Physical Therapists.

- Qualified Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist or Orthopaedic technician or Public Health and social fields
- At least 5 years of professional experience with an international aid organization
- Highly experienced in skills training
